

Flora and fauna: Main wall

BACKGROUND SHAPES AND COLOURS: inspired by the dense foliage and trees overlapping each other throughout the heathland area around Burgess Creek - large trees, vines, foliage.

To the right side, the colours lead into yellows and browns to symbolise the movement of Burgess Creek into the coastline and the blue to symbolise the ocean as it flows into it.

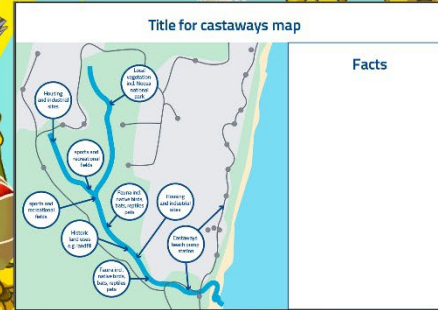
