


Harold the Hungry Toilet

"Billy, I'm so hungry, can I have something to eat?"





"Harold, I'm sure we can find you a treat!"

tell me what food?”


“Billy, I’m a toilet so

“Hmm, Harold, what about this old sock?”




“Billy, I’m a toilet, if I eat that I will block.”

the WORST of the lot!”






"Harold, eat these cotton buds, here have three!"

even get past the seat.”





