Position Purpose

As the Technology Portfolio Delivery Manager you will lead and manage a team of Project Managers and Business Systems Analysts. The position is essentially responsible for driving and facilitating business change through Technology.

The Technology Portfolio Delivery Manager provides subject matter expertise on requirements definition and the development of functional and technical specifications. The role actively manages the identification, prioritisation and allocation of work to business systems analysts. You will use your excellent communication and interpersonal skills to partner with business stakeholders and work with them to deliver strategic outcomes.

The Technology Portfolio Delivery Manager provides program level oversight of the Technology Portfolio ensuring that Unitywater methodologies are carried out and corporate standards are adhered to. This position ensures that, wherever possible, innovative and agile approaches are adopted to optimise delivery of successful project outcomes in the shortest possible times and at the lowest reasonable cost.

The team works closely with system user groups, projects and the EPMO and other business stakeholders to identify and define system improvements and develop functional and technical specifications and test plans for system changes. Project teams include internal business and Technology personnel as well as external vendor and contract specialists.



Position Accountabilities

Key functions of the role include:

- Lead and manage a team of Business System Analysts and Program/Project Managers including the prioritisation, assignment and tracking of work packages
- Plan and allocate work, setting priorities and completion timeframes. Monitor progress ensuring IT projects are completed on time, within budget, according to standards and quality requirements.
- Champion, develop, adapt and apply Unitywater approved methodologies for the solutions and projects lifecycles. Use an agile and responsive engagement model for system user groups and other business stakeholders
- Guide Technology Portfolio Team to design and implement relevant processes and documentation to ensure that the collection and definition of business requirements and functional and technical specifications is concise, accurate, traceable and reflective of business stakeholder needs
- Ensure the delivery is innovative, fit for purpose, adheres to architectural and functional standards and that solutions are architected to conform and comply with the Enterprise Architecture and adhere to Enterprise Architecture framework
- Develop and implement test plans for system enhancements and changes and establish automated and repeatable testing scenarios
- Manage both internal and external project team resources and responsible for establishing and managing vendor and supplier relationships related to project delivery, in conjunction with the Technology Vendor and Services team
- Identifies, proposes and influences business solutions and negotiates deliverables and requirements across multiple business system users
- Ensure that the design and integration of proposed system, software and hardware solutions leads to the development and growth of the business through effective use of technology
- Manage the design and implementation of new IT solutions and enhancements through Implementation to handover phase of the IT Lifecycle, including defining requirements for new IT services and managing smooth transition
- Develop and implement project and release management plans including the progress of release management plans
- Ensure the impacts of IT projects and system enhancements are appropriately communicated to the business
- Meet relevant ISO standard (Leader to Remove if not required).





- Support and role model the WH&S policies, procedures, and practices of Unitywater as amended from time to time.
- Participate in Unitywater safety audits and inspections to demonstrate visible safety leadership and participation.
- Such other relevant duties as required from time to time which would generally fall within the skill and knowledge requirements for this position.

Capability Requirements

The requirements for the position are:

- Tertiary qualification in Computer Science, Information Technology, or equivalent
- Program and/or Project Certification or similar with demonstrable skills to be able to manage and direct projects at a program and/or portfolio level
- Demonstrated strong analytical and project management skills, including thorough understanding of how to interpret customer business needs and translate them into application and operational requirements
- Demonstrated knowledge of the Utility industry and its trends
- Excellent collaboration, multi-tasking and organisation skills to effectively coordinate efforts, utilising proven knowledge of Business Systems and their responsibilities within the organisation
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills in order to lead communications across different IT (internal and external) and business teams, including the delivery of presentations to audiences of varied sizes
- Demonstrated proven ability to prioritise team tasks and drive other project team' business analysts toward successful project completion
- Ability to document business processes and information flows formally, in a clearly understood manner i.e. BPMN
- Demonstrated Leadership skills both within a project structure and line management, with ability to delegate work in order to maximise work throughput and quality
- Perform regular formal progress and status reporting
- Demonstrated experience in managing project teams in complex Technology environments
