



## Planting guide

Certain trees and shrubs planted too close to sewers, drains and water pipes can cause hidden leaks and sewer blockages and overflows on your property. We recommend you check this guide before planting any trees or shrubs in your garden.



## What to plant

| Austral indigo         | Indigofera australis    |
| Dogwood                | Jacksonia scoparia      |
| Dwarf banksia          | Banksia oblongifolia    |
| Hairy bush pea         | Pultenaea villosa       |
| Sweet wattle           | Acacia suaveolens       |
| Woombye bush           | Phebalium woombye       |
| Broad-leaved palm lily | Cordyline petiolaris    |
| Blueberry ash          | Elaeocarpus reticulatus |
| Plum myrtle            | Pilidiostigma glabrum   |
| Peanut tree            | Sterculia quadrifida    |

How far from water or sewerage pipes to plant

Plant directly above or up to 1.5m away from pipes

Plant between 1.5m and 3m away from pipes

Plant beyond 3m from pipes



## What not to plant

Golden Cane Palm Dypsis lutescens

Gum tree Eucalyptus sp.

Common fig

Lilly pilly (large species) Acmena sp., some Syzygium sp.

Umbrella tree Schefflera actinophylla

West African tulip Spathodea campanulata

Pine tree *Pinus sp.* 

Poinciana Delonix regia

Jacaranda Jacaranda mimosifolia

Broad-leaved paperbark *Melaluca quinquenervia* 

Weeping paperbark Melaluca leucadendron

Mango tree Mangifera indica

Coral tree *Erythrina sp.* 

Willow (all types) Salix sp.

Camphor Laurel Cinnamomum camphora

Wisteria Wisteria sp.

Black bean *Castanospermum australe*
