On behalf of the Moreton Bay and Sunshine Coast communities we:

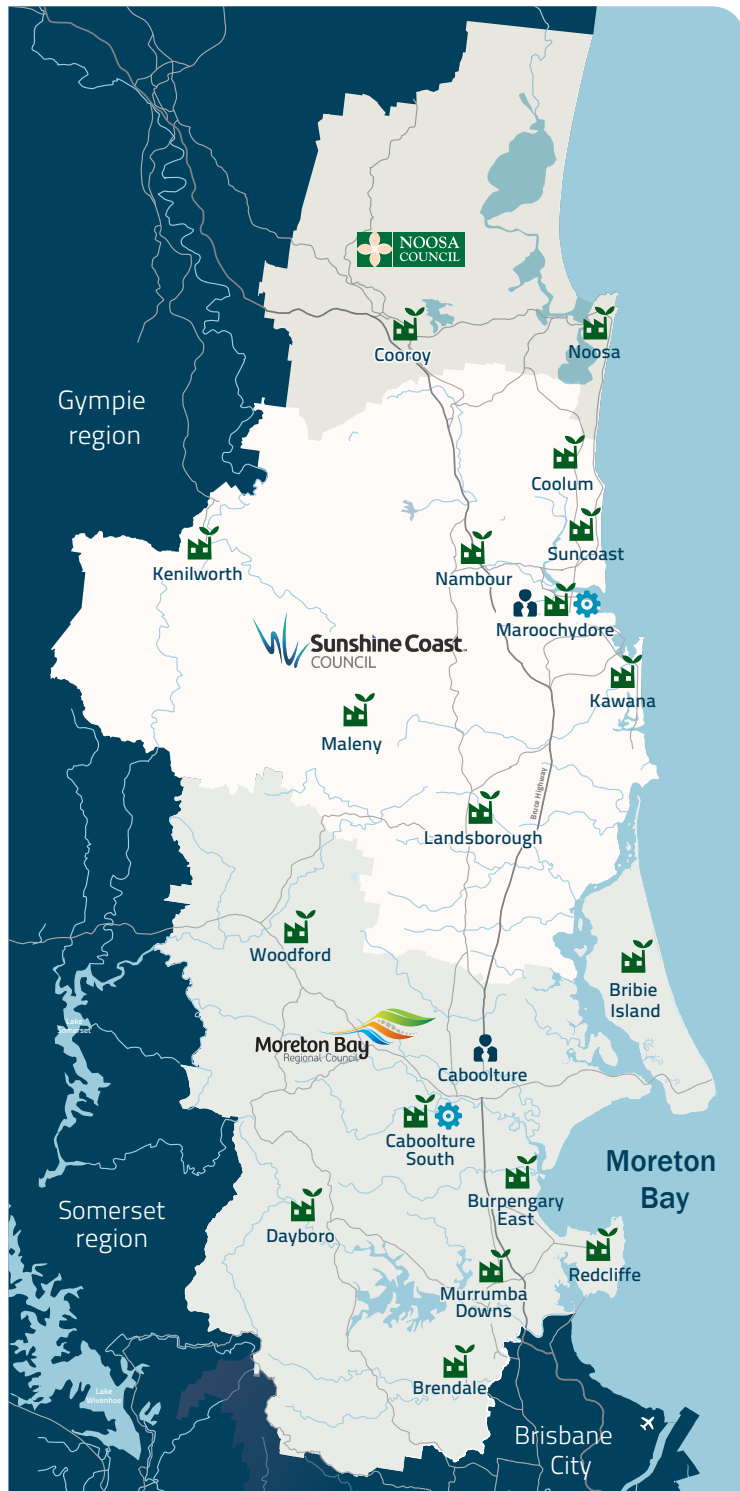
- maintain and supply drinking-quality water to homes, businesses and public areas
